Beadwork Special Projects Editor Jamie Hogsett Gets Knotty on Jewelry Making cable TV show this October

Loveland, Colo., October 1, 2005: The new fifth season of Jewelry Making begins airing this October on Wednesdays at 3 p.m. Eastern on DIY—the Do-It-Yourself Network—and will feature Jamie Hogsett, special projects editor of *Beadwork* magazine, as a guest instructor in “Knotty Girls,” episode 503.

Hogsett joins host Jackie Guerra to show four different knotting techniques, as featured in the biannual special issue *Stringing* magazine and her new book, *Stringing Style* (Interweave Press, October 2005).

In the second segment, Hogsett knots a colorful “elemental necklace” out of resin beads and yarn, then demonstrates how to parlay a few knotting techniques into fun and funky necklaces.

“Knotty Girls” with Jamie Hogsett airs October 19 at 3:00 p.m. Eastern and October 23, 2005, at 4:00 p.m. Eastern.

In case you missed Hogsett’s appearance in Jewelry Making Season 3, you can catch a re-run of episode DJMK #307 “Green with Envy” on October 21 at 11:00 a.m. Eastern. She’ll demonstrate how to create three very different lariat necklaces—her *Wonder Years Lariat*, *Emerald City Slider*, and *Green Fairy Lariat*—using a variety of green beads.
