- 3. Jane of the Jungle by Michelle Mach.** This narrow peyote bracelet looks a lot like camouflage and uses a range of matte greens, plus black and cream beads in a freeform peyote pattern.
- 4. Banded Tapestry Cuff by Kathy King.** This bracelet comes to life with added texture and dimension by incorporating netting between rows of peyote. Additional depth and interest are added by using crystals within the netted sections.

**5. Finger Food by Leslie Rogalski.** The final peyote project in this free e-Book is ideal for beginners who want to learn this popular stitch. Regular fans of this beadweaving technique will find this peyote pattern to be instant gratification.
