

Folk Shawls Errata

Rows 2 and 4: *K2, p2, k2, p8; repeat from * to 6 sts before last marker, end k2, p2, k2.

Row 3: *P2, yo, ssk, p2, k8; repeat from * to 6 sts before last marker, end p2, yo, ssk, p2.

Repeat Rows 1–4 for pattern.

Shawl

Using smaller needle, cast on 308 sts loosely (see page 11). Work in seed stitch for 12 rows. On next row work seed stitch, placing markers as follows: Work 8 sts, place marker, work to last 8 sts, place marker, work 8 sts. On the next row work in seed stitch increasing as follows:

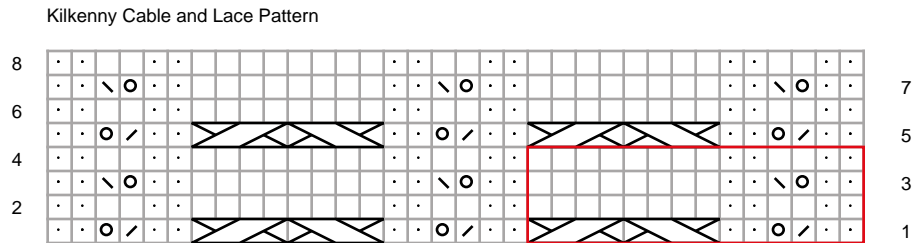
Work 18 sts, kfb, *work 12 sts, kfb; repeat from * 20 more times, work 17 sts—330 sts. Change to larger needle.

Maintain the seed stitch borders on the first and last 8 sts of each row. The cable and lace pattern is present in both written and charted form and is worked on the 314 sts between the markers.

Work in pattern until shawl measures about 28" (71 cm) from cast-on edge, ending with row 1. Change to smaller needle and work in seed stitch, dec in the next row as follows: Work 17 sts, k2tog, *work 12 sts, k2tog; repeat from * 20 more times, work 17 sts—308 sts. Work 13 rows of seed stitch. Bind off loosely.

Finishing

Use tapestry needle to weave in ends. Block.



Maintain seed stitch borders on the first and last 8 sts of each row.
