

In the simplest form of a half hitch, one active strand is looped around an adjoining passive strand. Using a series of half hitches, you can form thick fringe that spirals.

In this variation, only the left strand is active. It helps to keep tension on the right strand.

- 1 Bring the left strand over and behind the right strand, then through the space between the two strands (Figure A). Pull the knot tight.
- 2 Repeat Step 1 (Figure B).
