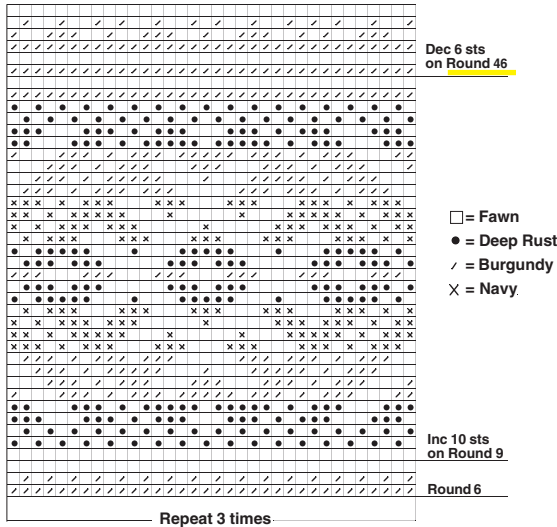
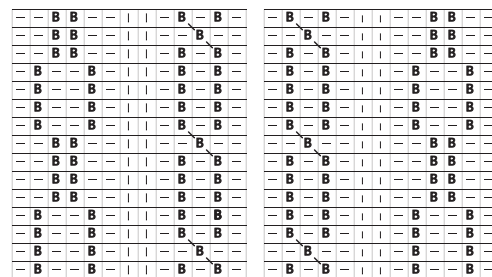


Cuff Pattern



Clock Patterns



Right Clock Pattern

Left Clock Pattern

- = purl
- | = knit
- B = knit through the back (twist the stitch)
- \ = work right st over left st

Materials: Nordic Fiber Arts’ Rauma Finullgarn 2-ply (100% wool, 50g/approx. 178 yards) #452 Fawn, 2 skeins; #444 Deep Rust, #480 Burgundy, #449 Navy, 1 skein each.

Set of four #0 double-point needles or size to give gauge.

Gauge: 15 sts and 22 rounds = 2 inches over Stockinette stitch worked in the round.

18 sts and 20 rounds = 2 inches over color patterning worked in the round.

LEG

CO 92 sts with Fawn over the index finger and Burgundy over the thumb using the Continental method. Divide the sts evenly onto 3 needles. Join into a round being careful not to twist sts. This join marks the “seam line” and beginning of the round.

- Round 1: Purl with Fawn.
- Round 2: Knit with Burgundy.
- Round 3: Purl with Burgundy.
- Round 4: Knit with Fawn.
- Round 5: Purl with Fawn.

Begin working pattern for cuff according to graph. Rnds 6–8: Work 2 repeats of stitches as shown, then work 24 sts more following chart to complete rnd—92 sts.

Rnd 9: Increase 10 sts evenly spaced—102 sts.
 Rnds 11–45: Repeat 34 motif sts 3 times each rnd.
 Rnd 46: Decrease 6 sts evenly spaced—96 sts. Cut all contrast colors, continue with Fawn.

Increase and decrease stitches evenly spaced on rounds 9 and 41 as indicated on graph. Work graph to end. 96 sts total. Cut all contrast colors. Continue with Fawn.

Begin clock patterns at sides

Round 1: K22, work Right Clock Pattern according to graph over next 13 sts. Knit next 26 sts. Work Left Clock Pattern over next 13 sts, k22 sts.

Rounds 2 & 3: Work even in established patterns.

SHAPE CALF

Round 4: *K1, SSK, k19 sts, work across 13 clock sts as established, k26 sts, work across 13 clock sts as established, k19 sts, k2 tog, k1. Repeat from * every 6th round 7 more times for a total of 8 repeats. Knit to end of round. 80 sts remain.

Continue even in established patterns until you have 9 twisted cable crossings from the beginning of the Clock Patterns. Work 1 more round in pattern.

Adjust the sts so that there are 20 sts on needle #1, 40 sts on
