

## Fibonacci Stripes Socks



One of my favorite stripe sequences is based on the Fibonacci series, where you begin with the numbers 1 and 2, then add the last two numbers of the series together to come up with the next. For example, the first 6 numbers of the series are 1, 2, 3, 5, 8, and 13. For working stripes, knit the specified number of rounds with one color, then the next specified number of rounds with a different color, etc. The three pairs of socks shown here are three variations of the same color theme—I rotated three colors among four units of the series (1, 2, 3, and 5).

These socks follow the basic pattern for 7 stitches/inch (see page 54) and are worked on four double-pointed needles.
