

# the fan

## RIGHT FRONT

With one strand of each yarn held tog, CO 181 sts. Work Rows 1–34 of Fan Border (see Stitch Guide)—159 sts rem after completing Row 34; piece measures about 3¾" (9.5 cm) from CO at deepest curve of scalloped edge. Cont in garter slip-stitch patt with shaping as foll:

**ROW 1** (RS) K1, sl 1 as if to purl with yarn in back (pwise wyb), k12, place 14 sts just worked on holder for collar extension, knit to end—145 sts rem.

**ROW 2** (WS) K1, sl 1 as if to purl with yarn in front (pwise wyf), k7, \*sl 1 pwise wyf, k13; rep from \* to last 10 sts, sl 1 pwise wyf, k7, p1, k1.

**NOTE** Sl the second st of every RS row pwise wyb, and sl all slipped stitches of every WS row pwise wyf.

**ROW 3** K1, sl 1, knit to end.

**ROWS 4–14** Rep **Rows 2 and 3** of patt 5 more times, then work Row 2 once more.

**ROW 15** (RS; shaping row) K1, sl 1, k5, k2tog, [k1, k2tog, k9, k2tog] 8 times, k1, k2tog, k12, [M1; see Glossary] 0 (1) time, k9—127 (128) sts rem.

**ROW 16** K1, sl 1, k7 (8), sl 1, k12, sl 1, [k11, sl 1] 8 times, k6, p1, k1.

**ROW 17** K1, sl 1, knit to end.

**ROWS 18–28** Rep Rows 16 and 17 of patt 5 more times, then work Row 16 once more.

**ROW 29** (RS; shaping row) K1, sl 1, k4, k2tog, [k1, k2tog, k7, k2tog] 8 times, [k1, k2tog, k20] 1 (0) time, [k14, M1, k10] 0 (1) time—109 (112) sts rem.

**ROW 30** K1, sl 1, k7 (9), sl 1, k11 (12), sl 1, [k9, sl 1] 8 times, k5, p1, k1.

**ROW 31** K1, sl 1, knit to end.

**ROWS 32–42** Rep Rows 30 and 31 of patt 5 more times, then work Row 30 once more.

**ROW 43** (RS; shaping row) K1, sl 1, k3, k2tog, [k1, k2tog, k5, k2tog] 8 times, [k1, k2tog, k19] 1 (0) time, [k14, M1, k11] 0 (1) time—91 (96) sts rem.

**ROW 44** K1, sl 1, k7 (10), sl 1, k10 (12), sl 1, [k7, sl 1] 8 times, k4, p1, k1.

**ROW 45** K1, sl 1, knit to end.

**ROWS 46–56** Rep Rows 44 and 45 of patt 5 more times, then work Row 44 once more.

**ROW 57** (RS; shaping row) K1, sl 1, k2, k2tog, [k1, k2tog, k3, k2tog] 8 times, [k1, k2tog, k18] 1 (0) time, [k14, M1, k12] 0 (1) time—73 (80) sts rem.

**ROW 58** K1, sl 1, k7 (11), sl 1, k9 (12), sl 1, [k5, sl 1] 8 times, k3, p1, k1.

**ROW 59** K1, sl 1, knit to end.

## FINISHED SIZE

37½ [44½]" [95 [113] cm] bust circumference. Sweater shown measures 37½" (95 cm).

## YARN

About 300 (350) grams of main color 1 (MC1) of fingering-weight (#1 Super Fine) yarn and 200 (250) grams of main color 2 (MC2) of laceweight (#0 Lace) yarn, used held tog.

*Shown here:* Highland (100% wool; 305 yd [279 m]/50 g): plaster (pink; MC1), 6 (7) skeins.

Alpaca 1 (100% alpaca; 437 yd [400 m]/50 g): #100 natural (MC2), 4 (5) skeins.

**Note:** Use one strand each of Highland and Alpaca 1 held together for MC. Plan on purchasing an extra skein of each yarn for the long-sleeve version.

## NEEDLES

Size U.S. 4 (3.5 mm): straight. Adjust needle size if necessary to obtain the correct gauge.

## NOTIONS

Stitch holders; tapestry needle; spare needle for three-needle bind-off.

## GAUGE

22½ stitches and 40½ rows = 4" (10 cm) in garter slip-stitch pattern of body and sleeves; one fan border pattern repeat [varies from 14 to 24 stitches] measures about 3" (7.5 cm) wide; 34 rows of fan border pattern measure about 3¾" (9.5 cm) high at deepest curve of scalloped edge.
