FINGERLESS MITTENS

These cozy fingerless mittens are so simple to knit, but the luxurious yarns and dainty lace edging make them a simply luxurious accessory. The gold and pink hues of the striped pair remind me of something worn by a princess in a fairy story, while the pink pair is classically feminine . . . so if you know anyone wanting to embrace her inner princess, these mittens would make the ideal gift.

FINISHED SIZE

6¼" (16 cm) circumference measured above thumb. Mittens will stretch to fit a woman's hand.

YARN

DK weight (#3 Light) and worsted weight (#4 Medium).

SHOWN HERE

striped mittens (opposite): Louisa Harding Grace (50% merino wool, 50% silk; 110 yd [101 m]/50 g): #2 soft gold (tan, A), **2 balls**; Louisa Harding Glisten (97% nylon, 3% polyester; 93 yd [85 m]/50 g): #4 gold (B), 1 ball; and Louisa Harding Impression (16% kid mohair, 84% polyamid; 154 yd [141 m]/50 g): #13 faded (pink/beige/silver, C), 1 ball.

plain mittens (page 76): Louisa Harding Grace (50% merino wool, 50% silk; 110 yd [101 m]/50 g): #4 rose, 1 ball.

NEEDLES

U.S. sizes 3 (3.25 mm), 5 (3.75 mm), and 6 (4 mm). Adjust needle size if necessary to obtain the correct gauge.

NOTIONS

Markers (m); tapestry needle.

GAUGE

24 sts and 32 rows = 4" (10 cm) in St st on largest needles.
