



Trinity Lace: (multiple of 6 sts plus 3)

Row 1: (RS) *Yo, sl 2 sts as if to k2tog, k1, pass 2 slipped sts over (p2sso), yo, k3; rep from * to last 3 sts, yo, sl 2 as if to k2tog, k1, p2sso, yo.

Rows 2 and 4: (WS) Purl.

Row 3: *K3, yo, sl 2 sts as if to k2tog, k1, p2sso, yo; rep from * to last 3 sts, k3.

Repeat Rows 1–4 for pattern.

BRIM

With MC and shorter smaller-size cir needle, CO 117 (130, 143) sts. Do not join for working in the rnd. Knit 2 rows—1 garter st ridge. *Next row:* (RS) Place marker (pm) of contrasting color, *k13, place 2 markers next to each other; rep from * 7 (8, 9) more times, k13. Join for working in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. *Next rnd:* *Work first 13 sts according to Rnd 1 of Brim chart, slip marker (sl m), yo, sl m; rep from * 8 (9, 10) more times—126 (140, 154) sts. Cont in patt until Rnd 32 has been completed, inc as shown on chart and changing to longer smaller-size cir needle when there are too many sts to fit comfortably around the shorter cir needle—261 (290, 319) sts.

Brim Edging

Change to CC and larger cir needle.

Rnd 1: *[K2tog twice, k1] 5 times, k2tog twice; rep from * 8 (9, 10) more times—153 (170, 187) sts.

Rnd 2: *K2, yo, k3, yo, k7, yo, k5; rep from * 8 (9, 10) more times—180 (200, 220) sts.

Rnds 3 and 5: Knit.

Rnd 4: *K2, yo, k5, yo, k8, M1 (see Glossary, page 155), k5; rep from * 8 (9, 10) more times—207 (230, 253) sts.

Rnd 6: *K2, yo, k7, yo, k8, yo, k6; rep from * 8 (9, 10) more times—234 (260, 286) sts.

Rnd 7: Knit, removing markers between reps as you come to them.

With knitting needle or larger crochet hook as desired, BO all sts using the picot method (see Stitch Guide).

CROWN

With MC, shorter smaller-size cir needle, and RS facing, pick up and knit 1 st from each CO st along inner edge of brim, pm every 13 sts, and using a contrasting m at end of rnd—117 (130, 143) sts. **Work the 13-st pattern repeat of Rnd 1 of the Brim chart (the 13 sts between the blue lines) 9 (10, 11) times around. Cont in pattern from Brim chart as established until crown measures 2 [2.5, 3]" [5 [6.5, 7.6] cm] from pick-up rnd.** Work Rnds 1–19 of Crown chart, changing to dpn when there are too few sts to fit around cir needle—9 (10, 11) sts rem. Cut yarn, leaving an 8" (20.5 cm) tail. Thread tail on tapestry needle, draw through rem sts, pull tight to close top of crown, and fasten off to WS. Weave in loose ends.
