

(21, 23, 27) sts seed st, pm, k2, p4, (k4, p4) 4 times, **k2**, pm, work 19 (21, 23, 27) sts seed st. On the next row (RS), work 19 (21, 23, 27) sts seed st, work center 40 sts from Row 1 of lattice and cable chart, work 19 (21, 23, 27) sts seed st. Work even in patterns as established until piece measures $13\frac{1}{2}$ (14, $14\frac{1}{2}$, 15)" (34.5 [35.5, 37, 38] cm) with bottom edge rolled up, ending with a WS row. Armhole shaping: BO 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows—74 (78, 82, 90) sts. Work even in patterns until piece measures $23\frac{1}{2}$ ($24\frac{1}{2}$, $25\frac{1}{2}$, $26\frac{1}{2}$)" (59.5 [62, 65, 67.5] cm) with bottom edge rolled up, or $\frac{1}{2}$ " (1.3 cm) less than desired length, ending with a WS row. Shape back neck: Work 17 (19, 21, 25) sts in pattern, join new ball of yarn, BO center 40 sts, work in pattern to end. Working each side separately, work even in pattern until piece measures 24 (25, 26, 27)" (61 [63.5, 66, 68.5] cm) with bottom edge rolled up. Place 17 (19, 21, 25) sts for each shoulder on separate holders.

Front

Work as for back until piece measures $20\frac{1}{2}$ ($21\frac{1}{2}$, $22\frac{1}{2}$, $23\frac{1}{2}$)" (52 [54.5, 57, 59.5] cm) with bottom edge rolled

up, or $3\frac{1}{2}$ " (9 cm) less than desired length, ending with a WS row. Shape front neck: Work 25 (27, 29, 33) sts in pattern, join new ball of yarn, BO center 24 sts (lattice section of center panel), work in pattern to end. Working each side separately, decrease 1 st at each neck edge every other row 8 times—17 (19, 21, 25) sts at each side. Work even in pattern until piece measures 24 (25, 26, 27)" (61 [63.5, 66, 68.5] cm) with bottom edge rolled up. Place 17 (19, 21, 25) sts for each shoulder on separate holders.

Sleeves

Matching right front and back shoulders, with right sides of fabric held together, join right shoulder using three-needle bind-off technique. Repeat for left shoulder. With RS facing, using larger needles, beginning at inner corner of armhole notch, pick up and knit 66 (68, 72, 74) sts evenly from one armhole notch to the other (using crochet hook for assistance, if desired). On the next row (WS), work as follows, pm between st panels where indicated, if desired: Work 29 (30, 32, 33) sts seed st, pm, k2, p4, k2, pm, work 29 (30, 32, 33) sts seed st. On the
