Tips

To ensure that your netting lays flat, pass the needle through shared beads so that it is parallel to the thread already in the hole. Do not angle your needle or cross or pierce the previous thread!

Bead netting will stretch or sag in the opposite direction from which it was worked. In other words, if the thread goes crosswise, the work may stretch lengthwise.

Increasing

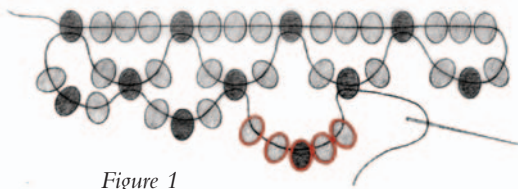

1. Increase by using more bridge beads in each set. (Area of increase shown with red outline.)

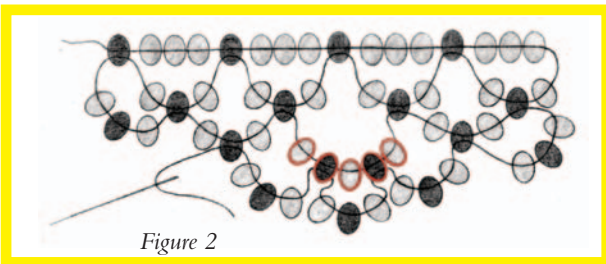

2. Increase by adding more shared beads.

Decreasing

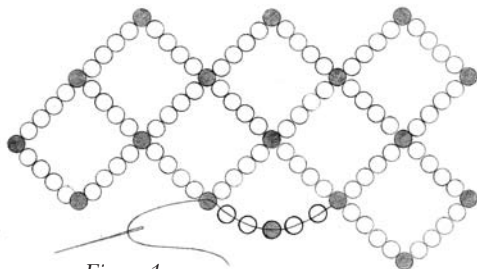

Connect shared beads with fewer (or none) bridge beads than the previous row.

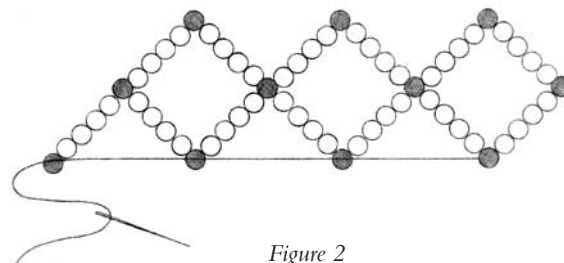
