Add beads as follows: 18D, (1L, 1D) 4 times, 1L, 18D, (1L, 1D) 4 times, 1L, 18D, (1L, 1D) 4 times, 1L, 18D.

Go into the center bead of a loop in the next tube. Knot between the beads (see page 27). Repeat pattern for strand. Go into the center bead of the next loop in the first tube. Knot between the beads. Continue back and forth until there are 16 strands.

Connect the last tube (the one with the button side of the closure) and the second last tube in the same way.

Adding the Center Strands

Connect the center strands between the second and third tubes using the following pattern:

18D, (1L, 1D) 4 times, 1L, 18D, (1L, 1 3-mm) 5 times, 1L, 18D, (1L, 1 3-mm) 11 times, 1L, 18D, (1L, 1 3-mm) 5 times, 1L, 18D, (1L, 1D) 4 times, 1 L, 18D.

For a longer necklace, use 6 tubes instead of 4 and adjust length of strands as desired.

White Dots Pattern (B = black, W = white)

Row 1: 32 B

Rows 2–14: BWB

Rows 15 and 16: BBB
