

## Back

With A and smaller needles, CO 100 (114, 128, 142, 142, 156) sts. Knit 1 row. Do not cut yarn. Join C and knit 2 rows. Do not cut yarn. With A, knit 2 rows—piece measures about ½" (1.3 cm) from CO. Work Rows 3–32 of maze mosaic patt (see Stitch Guide or chart), then work Rows 1–32 two (two, three, three, three, three) times, then work Rows 1–24 (24, 4, 4, 10, 10)—piece measures same as front to armholes.

### Shape Armholes

(Row 25 [25, 5, 5, 11, 11] of maze patt) BO 4 (5, 7, 10, 10, 10) sts at beg of next 2 rows—92 (104, 114, 122, 122, 136) sts rem. Dec 1 st each end of needle every RS row 2 (3, 4, 5, 8, 13) times—88 (98, 106, 112, 106, 110) sts rem. Work even in patt until armholes measure 6¾ (6¾, 7½, 7½, 8½, 9)" (17 [17, 19, 19, 21.5, 23] cm), or same as front to shoulder shaping, ending with a WS row.

### Shape Shoulders

(RS) Keeping in patt, k27 (31, 33, 35, 35, 35), BO center 34 (36, 40, 42, 36, 40) sts, knit to end—27 (31, 33, 35, 35, 35) sts rem each side. Keeping in patt, work each side separately in short-rows as foll.

### Left Shoulder

**Row 1:** (WS) Purl.

**Row 2:** (RS) Rejoin second color, k1, ssk (see Glossary, page 154), work in patt to last 6 (7, 8, 8, 8, 8) sts, wrap next st, turn work—1 st dec'd at neck edge.

**Row 3:** Purl to end.

**Row 4:** K1, ssk, work in patt to last 12 (14, 16, 16, 16, 16) sts, wrap next st, turn—1 st dec'd at neck edge.

**Row 5:** Purl to end.

**Row 6:** K1, ssk, work 4 (5, 5, 6, 6, 6) sts, wrap next st, turn—1 st dec'd at neck edge.

**Row 7:** Purl to end.

**Row 8:** With A, knit to end, working wrapped sts tog with their wraps. Place rem 24 (28, 30, 32, 32, 32) sts on holder.

### Right Shoulder

**Row 1:** (WS) Rejoin yarn at neck edge, purl to end.

**Row 2:** (RS) Knit first 6 (7, 8, 8, 8, 8) sts using the stranded knitting technique (see Notes), work in mosaic patt as established to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1—1 st dec'd at neck edge.

**Row 3:** Keeping in patt, p20 (23, 24, 26, 26, 26), wrap next st, turn.

**Row 4:** K6 (7, 8, 8, 8, 8) in stranded knitting as before, work in patt to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1—1 st dec'd at neck edge.

**Row 5:** P13 (15, 15, 17, 17, 17), wrap next st, turn.

**Row 6:** K6 (7, 7, 8, 8, 8) in stranded knitting as before, work in patt to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1—1 st dec'd at neck edge.

**Row 7:** P6 (7, 7, 8, 8, 8), wrap next st, turn.

**Row 8:** Knit to end in stranded knitting.

**Row 9:** With A, purl to end, working wrapped sts tog with their wraps. Place rem 24 (28, 30, 32, 32, 32) sts on holder.

## Sleeves

With A and largest needles, CO 53 (53, 59, 59, 65, 65) sts. Knit 5 rows, ending with a WS row—piece measures about ½" (1.3 cm) from CO. Work lace patt as foll, slipping all slip sts kwise.

**Row 1:** (RS) K2, ssk, \*[k1, yo] 2 times, k1, sl 1, k2tog, pssso; rep from \* to last 7 sts, [k1, yo] 2 times, k1, k2tog, k2.

**Row 2:** Purl.

**Rows 3–6:** Rep Rows 1 and 2 two more times.

Dec 1 st each end of needle every 6th row 5 (4, 5, 4, 5, 4) times by working (sl 1, k2tog, pssso) in place of ssk at beg of row and in place of k2tog at end of row as foll:
