Page 39

The Stitch Guide should include the following:

Cluster-2: All in same st: [yo over hook twice, insert hook in st, yo hook and draw through a loop, yo hook, draw through 2 loops, yo hook, draw through 2 loops] 2 times, yo hook, draw through all 3 loops on hook.

Row 1 should be a WS row, and Row 2 should be a RS row. For Rows 3 - 22, odd-numbered rows are WS, and even-numbered rows are RS.

Page 40

Row 8: Ch 5 (counts as 1 dc and ch 2), work 3 sc into the closing ch of first puff st, *ch 3, 3 sc into closing ch of next puff st; rep from * **22 more times to last ch-3 and 2 sc, ch 2, skip ch-3 and 1 sc, 1 dc in last sc.**

Row 9: Ch 1, 1 sc in first dc, 2 sc in first ch-2 space, *1 sc in each of next 3 sc, 3 sc into next ch-3 sp; rep from * **22 more times, ending 1 sc in each of next 3 sc, 2 sc in ch-2 sp, 1 sc in 3rd ch of ch-5 from previous row.**

Page 41

Row 12: ... rep from * **12 more times until 6 more hdc and 5 more ch-1 sp remain, [1 dc in hdc, 1 dc in ch-1 sp] 4 times, 1 dc in hdc, 1 dc in ch-1 sp, 1 dc in top ch of ch-3 from previous row.**

Row 13: **Ignore** the phrase "end last rep by working (skip 3 sts, 1 sc) in last st (instead of skip 4 sts)." If you skip 4 sts as usual, then the final sc can be worked in the top ch of the ch-3 turning ch from previous row and the stitch count will come out correctly. The patt rep should be repeated a total of eight times—8 complete flower patts.

Row 14: Ch 3, **cluster-2** in second ch of ch-3 just worked, *ch 3, **cluster-2** in the top of the cluster just completed, 1 dc in dc, ch 3, 1 sc in ch-3 space at center of double cluster-3 in row below, ch 3, 1 dc in dc, ch 3, **cluster-2** in first ch of ch-3 just worked, **skip 3 ch of the ch-5 in row below, cluster-3 in next ch**, skip the next [1 ch, 1 sc, 1 ch] group of sts, **cluster-3 in next ch**; rep from * **6 more times, ending ch 3, cluster-2 in the top of the cluster just completed, 1 dc in dc, ch 3, 1 sc in ch-3 space at cen-**

ter of double cluster-3 in row below, ch 3, 1 dc in dc, ch 3, cluster-2 in first ch of ch-3 just worked, cluster-3 in last sc.

Row 15: Ch 3, **cluster-2** in top of cluster-3 at end of previous row, *ch 3, 1 dc in dc, ch 5, 1 sc in sc, ch 5, 1 dc in dc, ch 3, double cluster-3 in center of paired cluster-3 in row below; rep from * 6 more times, ch 3, 1 dc in dc, ch 5, 1 sc in sc, ch 5, 1 dc in dc, ch 3, cluster-3 in top of **beg cluster-2 from Row 14.**

Row 16: *Ch 3, 1 dc in dc, ch 3, **cluster-2** in first ch of ch-3 just completed, **skip 3 ch, cluster-3 in next ch**, skip [1 ch, 1 sc, 1 ch], **cluster-3 in next ch**, ch 3, **cluster-2** in first ch of ch-3 just completed, 1 dc in dc, ch 3, **1 sc in ch-3 space at center of double cluster-3 in row below**, rep from * 7 more times, **ending last rep with 1 sc in top of cluster-2 from previous row.**

Page 42

Row 17: **Ch 1, 1 sc in first sc**, *ch 5, 1 dc in dc, ch 3, double cluster-3 in center of paired cluster-3 of Row 16, ch 3, 1 dc in dc, ch 5, 1 sc in sc; rep from * 7 more times, ending last rep by working sc **into the top of the cluster at end of Row 15.**

Neck trim: Rejoin yarn to top of **left front opening, WS facing.**

Row 1: (WS) Working **along opposite side of beg ch, work 1 sc in each st across until 3 sts rem, ch 2, skip 2 sts (forms buttonhole), 1 sc in last st--85 sts, counting the ch-2 as 2 sts. Turn.**

Page 43

Row 2: (RS) Ch 2, working in **back** loops only, work 1 hdc in each of next 6 sts, *skip 1 st, work 1 hdc in each of next 8 sts; rep from * **until 7 sts rem**, end skip 1 st, 1 hdc in each of the last 6 sts. Turn.

Row 3: (slightly shapes front neck) Ch 1, sl st over the first 5 sts, sc in **front** loops of next 7 sts, hdc in **front** loops of next 3 sts, dc in **front** loops to last 1.5 sts, hdc in **front** loops of next 3 sts, sc in **front** loops of next 7 sts, sl st to end. Turn.

Continue with Row 4 and the front edgings as printed.
