



### ***Knight's Edging***

CO 6 sts.

Rows 1, 2 and 3: Work in seed st.

Rows 4 and 8: CO 3 sts, work to end in established seed st—12 sts after Row 8.

Rows 5, 6, 7, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, and 15: Work in seed st.

Rows 16 and 20: BO 3 sts, work to end in seed st—6 sts.

Rows 17, 18, 19: Cont in seed st.

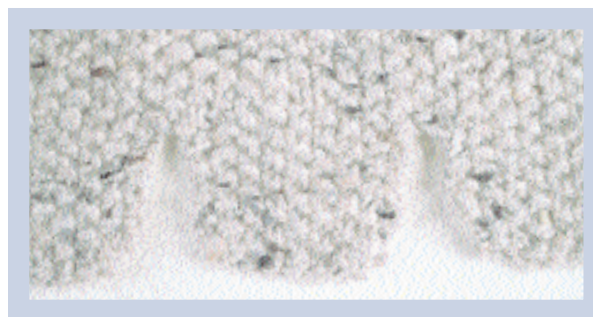
Rep Rows 1–20 for desired length.

### ***Serf's Edging***

*Note:* Each square is worked separately.

CO 9 sts.

Rows 1–10: Work in seed st. Break yarn and leave sts on needle—this forms one square. On the same needle, CO 9 sts and work Rows 1–10. Cont in this way until there are desired number of squares on needle. Do not break yarn after last square, but CO 2 sts, turn and knit across all squares on needle, CO 1 st bet each square and 2 sts at end of row.



*Serf's edging can make an interesting button-hole band.*
