

With dpns, work knit cord (page 149) for desired length (shown in CC). Make Picot Chain Flower (page 32) and attach to base of cord for leaves. Sew seam. Stuff fiberfill or cotton ball in bell for shaping.



Pansy

Flower back: With A, CO 24 sts.

Row 1: (WS) Purl.

Row 2: K2, *k1, slip this st back to left needle, lift the next 9 sts on left needle over this st and off needle, [yo] 2 times, knit the first st again, k2; rep from *—12 sts.

Row 3: K1, *p2tog, drop 1 yo, ([k1f&b] 2 times) in rem yo, p1; rep from * to last st, k1—14 sts.

Row 4: *K3tog; rep from *, end k2tog—5 sts.

Row 5: P2tog, p1, p2tog—3 sts.

BO all sts.

Flower front: With B, CO 38 sts.

Row 1: (WS) Purl.

Row 2: K2, *k1, slip this st back to left needle, lift the next 9 sts on left needle over this st and off needle, [yo] 2 times, knit the first st again, k2; rep from *—17 sts.

Row 3: K1, *p2tog, drop 1 yo, ([k1f&b] 2 times) in rem yo, p1; rep from * to last st, k1—20 sts.

Row 4: Change to A. *K3tog; rep from *, end k2—8 sts.

Row 5: Purl.

BO all sts. Sew flower front to flower back. Embroider 3 straight sts (page 192) on each front petal. Work French knot (page 203) in center, wrapping yarn 5 times around needle.

Picot Flower with Beads

Using provisional method (page 259), CO 61 sts.

Rows 1, 3, 5, and 7: (RS) Knit.

Rows 2 and 6: Purl.

Row 4: P1, *yo, p2tog; rep from *.

Row 8: Carefully remove waste yarn from CO sts and place live sts on a spare dpn. Hold this needle in front of and parallel to working needle. Fold at picot edge. *P2tog (1 st from each needle); rep from *.
