

## Lace from the Attic

*Row 21:* Sl 1 wyb, knit to marker, k2, [yo twice, k2tog] 3 times, k3, k2tog, yo, k2.

*Row 22:* YO, k2tog, k7, [p1, k2] 3 times, k1, turn.

*Row 23:* Sl 1 wyb, k11 (7 sts rem

on left needle), pass 5 sts on left needle over 1st st, k2tog.

*Row 24:* Knit to marker. Turn.

*Row 25:* Sl 1 wyb, k1, yo twice, k2tog, k4, k2tog, yo, k2.

Repeat Rows 2–25 nine times

more, but do not turn on last rep of Row 24. Remove waste thread and graft live sts to beg sts to form a circle. Weave in loose ends, closing up hole in center. Block.

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## Fairy Lace Doily

The border of this doily is worked in a strip and grafted into a circle. Stitches are picked up

around the inner edge of the loop and the rest of the doily is worked in the round to the center.



**Thread:** Size 10 crochet cotton: 1 ball (MC).

**Needles:** Size 3 (3.25 mm): 16" circular (cir) and set of 4 double-pointed (dpn).

**Notions:** Small amount of waste thread in contrasting color; markers; tapestry needle.

**Border:** With cir needle and waste thread, CO 12 sts, Knit 4 rows. Change to MC and knit 1 row. Work Rows 1–4 of Fairy Lace (see page 32) 60 times. Do not BO. Remove waste thread and graft ends tog to form a circle.

With cir needle, pick up and knit 1 st from each loop on straight edge of border—120 sts. Place marker. Knit 1 rnd. Purl 1 rnd. Knit 1 rnd. K14, k2tog, [k28, k2tog] 3 times, k14—116 sts. Place marker every 29 sts for corners.

*Note:* Change to dpn when necessary.

*Rnd 1:* ([SSK, yo] 6 times, k1, sl 2
