Rules and Entry Form

Send us your pincushion creations postmarked no later than March 1, 2008. Entries will be judged by the editors of *PieceWork* Magazine, and the juried pieces will be exhibited at The National NeedleArt Association's (TNNA) June 2008 trade show in Columbus, Ohio. In addition, winning pieces will be pictured in a 2008 issue of *PieceWork*.

Judging criteria will include originality of the pieces and mastery of the chosen technique. Pieces sent after March 1, 2008, will not be judged.

- Pincushions must incorporate at least one of the following techniques: cross-stitch, needlepoint, crochet, knit, lacemaking, tatting, quilting, embroidery. We are very excited to announce an additional new category: "Next Generation Embroiderer," open to stitchers who are between the ages of 15 and 25; entries in this category must incorporate embroidery.
- Pincushions must be hand-made and no larger than 4" x 4" x 4".
- The original work (not a photograph, please) must be entered. Supplementary photographs about your work or process are welcome.
- Each entry must be accompanied by a \$10 entry fee, payable by check to *PieceWork* Magazine. This entry fee will be used for return shipping of each piece. Limit of 3 entries per participant. Each pincushion must have its own entry form.
- If you would like your pincushion considered for a project submission to *PieceWork* magazine, please include written instructions and any necessary diagrams or charts for making your pincushion.
