

pattern

With Tunisian hook, loosely ch 132.

ROW 1 (RS): *Fwd:* Working in bumps on wrong side of ch, pull up a lp in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across—132 sts. *Rtn:* Yo, pull through 1 lp on hook, *yo, pull through 2 lps on hook; rep from * to end—1 lp on hook.

ROW 2: *Fwd:* Tps next 2 sts tog, *yo from front to back, Tps next 2 sts tog; rep from * until 1 st rem, yo from back to front, pull up lp in final st working under both strands. *Rtn:* Yo, pull through 1 lp on hook, *yo, pull through 2 lps on hook; rep from * to end.

ROW 3: *Fwd:* Sk next st, *yo from front to back, Tps next 2 sts tog (this will include one st from each of the 2 pairs from previous row); rep from * until 2 sts remain, yo from front to back, Tps in next st, pull up lp in final st working under both strands. *Rtn:* Yo, pull through 1 lp on hook, *yo, pull through 2 lps on hook; rep from * to end.

ROWS 4–101: Rep Rows 2–3, ending after a Row 3 Rtn.

BIND-OFF: Bind off in sl st as if to Tss leaving final st unworked, switch to standard hook, cont with edging.




EDGING

Mark first st of each rnd.

Do not join rnds unless instructed.

RND 1: With standard hook, (sc, hdc, sc) in end of final row, *working in ends



of rows, sc2tog over first 2 rows, sc in each of next 96 rows, sc2tog over next 2 rows*, *(sc, hdc, sc) in end of Row 1, working in opposite side of foundation ch, sc2tog over first 2 sts, [sc in each

of next 5 sts, sc2tog over next 2 sts] 18 times, sc in each of next 4 sts, (sc, hdc, sc) in end of Row 1; rep from * to ** once, (sc, hdc, sc) in end of Row 102, working in bind-off sl sts, sc2tog over
